*What should I do when I cannot find the Digital Object Identifier (DOI) number:*⁹

Let's say that you have performed a search in the ProQuest Sociology database for the subject "human trafficking":



The first entry you see ...



...is an entry that does not show the DOI number in the database's abstract/indexing. This article's "indexing" is shown below:

Once you have an email address that has been registered with CrossRef:

Make sure to double-check the citation for APA style accuracy before submitting in your written work.

If you cannot locate a DOI through CrossRef:

If CrossRef does not produce the DOI for you, you will be expected to do a little more research to make sure that the DOI is truly not available for the article. For instance, in the article citation information above, it states that the article's publisher is Taylor and Francis. You will need to perform a Google search for either the journal itself (which will likely lead you to the publisher unless the journal has its own website) or the publisher.

If you still cannot locate a DOI:

After looking for the citation on CrossRef and the publisher's website, if you determine that there is no DOI for that article, you will use the URL for the publisher's website.
